BRAKES MOULD & MILDEW REMOVER



A power cleaner which removes black mould and mildew stains from tile grouting, mastic and plastic shower curtains in poor ventilated bathroom areas within the leisure and hospitality markets

HOW TO USE

Brakes Mould & Mildew Remover is used directly from the bottle as a ready to go solution and requires no dilution with water.

- In hotel room cleaning housekeepers should treat the mould and mildew staining on tile grouting in the bathroom as one of the first cleaning operations to give the products as much time to affect the mould as possible. As it is a bleaching agent care must be taken not to use product within the bedroom itself.
- Direct and spray affected area from approximately 30cm with the foaming trigger spray, so that the product clings to vertical surfaces. Leave product in contact with surface for as long as possible before wiping and/or rinsing away. Some ingrained mould or mildew may require more than one application.
- Utilising the foaming trigger head spray the affected area from approximately 30cm to allow the product to cling to vertical surfaces.
- Treat mould removal as one of the first cleaning tasks to maximise the contact time whilst cleaning other areas. Rinse off with water after cleaning. Ingrained staining may require more than one application.

- Contains a bleaching agent so care must be taken not to use the product within the bedroom and avoid contact with fabric or clothing, unpainted surfaces, lightly glazed/unglazed tiles, coloured grouts or damaged enamel surfaces.
- **Caution: Never use this product in conjunction with an acid based product.**
