BRAKES GLASS RENOVATING POWDER



A specialised glass renovating powder detergent formulated to effectively remove unsightly detergent and rinse aid films, lipstick and hard water blooming from drinking glasses and polycarbonates. It can also be used as a weekly maintenance product for glass washing machines.

HOW TO USE

- Hand dosed using the 50g scoop provided.
- Ensure the glass washer is operating at the correct wash temperature and that all jets and filters are clean.
- Dissolve 4 to 6 scoops of powder into the wash tank and wash in the normal manner.
- If renovating a large number of glasses, add 1 additional scoop of powder every 8 washes.
- There is no need to disconnect the normal chemical dosing system during the renovation process.
- Keep container tightly closed in a cool dry place and store in a safe manner in a locked storage area away from the general public.
- Never mix chemicals together or re-fill containers from other vessels or drums.

Caution: This product is designed for glass refurbishment and periodic glass washer cleaning and is not recommended for continuous use.
