PRODUCT GUIDANCE SHEET

BRAKES COLOURED BEERLINE CLEANER



A powerful and non-chlorinated line cleaning liquid which contains a heavy duty blend of alkalis and non-foaming detergents that rapidly breaks down yeasts and other beer/juice/wine line residues. Also contains a blue colour indicator to assist identifying line flushing has been completed safely.

HOW TO USE

Brakes Coloured Beerline Cleaner is a highly concentrated product and it must be diluted with water before use. It is normally dispensed using a 30ml pelican dispensing pump fitted to the 5lt container.

Due to the volume required it should be dispensed from the container with extreme care. It can also be pumped automatically through an automated beer line cleaning system.

- Shut off CO2 to the beer kegs and connect to the cleaning system - this is usually a plastic cleaning vessel.
- Flush the lines with clean water to remove any loose debris before cleaning.
- Make up the cleaning solution – we recommend an 80:1 dilution ratio with water (approximately 12mls per litre of water, or 250mls in a 20lt cleaning container).
- A stronger solution may be needed depending on the type of beers being served and how often the lines are cleaned.

- Draw the chemical/water cleaning solution into the system until a blue colour is visible at the pumps and leave in the lines for approximately 20 minutes contact time.
- Then draw off one pint glass of solution from each line and leave for a further 20 minutes.
- Draw off all the remaining solution and thoroughly flush with clean cold water.
- Continue flushing until the blue indicator of the solution is no longer visible from any of the lines.
- Finally reconnect the beer kegs and pull beer as normal.
