PRODUCT GUIDANCE SHEET

BRAKES FLOOR POLISH



A dry-bright, metalised emulsion floor polish containing a blend of acrylic polymers and waxes, specially formulated to provide a durable high gloss finish to porous and sealed floor surfaces including vinyl, linoleum, wood, stone and some types of marble. Enhances the appearance of high traffic flooring in the hospitality, education, leisure and business sectors.

HOW TO USE

This product should not be diluted, and should be used as supplied to leave a final finish to hard floors so it is vitally important that this coating is laid correctly.

- Pour small amounts onto the floor and apply by mop (preferably a flat mop) into all corners and edges first.
- Moving backwards from the furthest part of the room, cover the floor making your way to the door.
- Lay the polish down in several thin coats, with each coat applied at a 90 degree angle to the previous coat ensuring full coverage and no patches.
- Each coat must be allowed to completely dry before applying more to ensure they bond effectively.

Initial Preparation:

Mop down and clean the floor using a neutral detergent. Then remove old polish or wax using an effective emulsion polish floor stripper. Ensure the surface is perfectly dry before finally sweeping the floor to remove any dust or debris.

Application:

Apply a thin even coat using a lambs-wool applicator or suitable flat-mopping system for even coverage. Allow this coat to dry completely before applying a second coat. The polish will dry to a high gloss finish in approximately one hour if the room is well ventilated. The floor can then be opened to traffic.

SAFETY ADVICE

Not classified as hazardous, however we advise that normal cleaning safety practises are adopted. Wear rubber gloves when handling and avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention if irritation persists.
