HOW TO USE

Brakes Pearlised Liquid Hand Soap is used directly from the refillable soap dispenser with the blue teardrop. Always make sure that soap dispensers are always filled with soap.

Important Note:

Always wash hands following handling raw food, refuse or visiting the toilet.

Good Hand Washing Practice:

- Washing hands may seem easy but it can cause problems if not conducted properly.
- Ensure you wet your hands first then apply the soap. Remember chemicals need water to work.
- Make sure you clean your hands, in between your fingers and your finger nails properly.
- Finally, make sure you rinse all the soap off your hands once you have finished with clean water.
- Then dry with a paper towel. Any residues of the soap on your skin may cause an irritation with prolonged contact.

Keep Dispensers Hygienically Clean:

As a frequently touched piece of equipment, care should be taken to ensure that the soap dispensers are kept hygienically clean and that residues of soap are periodically wiped from surrounds of the dispenser and the vending nozzle.
