BRAKES DRAIN DOSING CONCENTRATE



A concentrated blend of natural micro-organisms, enzymes and biodegradable surfactants designed to digest fats, grease and organic matter in an environmentally safe manner.

HOW TO USE

Suitable for commercial kitchen drains and fat/grease traps and particularly beneficial for sites with their own waste treatment processes or septic tank. When dosed into the drain, the 'friendly' bacteria create enzymes to accelerate the natural degradation process, turning potentially drain blocking fats into harmless simple sugars, carbon dioxide and water.

Brakes Drain Dosing Concentrate is added automatically to the drain or grease trap by an electronic free-on-loan drain dosing unit. The dosing unit is pre-programmed to operate at a time when the site is less active (generally at night). This 'rest' period allows the greatest interval for the product to digest organic matter.

Normally a daily dose rate of 150 - 200mls is sufficient to maintain drains and grease traps. A 20litre container will provide 100 days' treatment when dosed at 200mls per day.

Caution:

Many of the other chemicals used in normal hygiene processes can inhibit the effectiveness of biological products therefore for optimum performance the dose time is important and should take into account individual site operations.

The biological action of micro-organisms and enzymes is reduced by the presence of strong acids and alkalis and can be stopped by the over use of disinfecting agents, especially chlorine bleach. It is understood that the use of these

chemicals may be necessary to maintain hygiene standards. It is therefore recommended that at the end of the cleaning operation (normally at the end of the day/shift) that the sinks or drains are flushed with clean water to wash away chemical residues before the product is auto-dosed.

SAFETY ADVICE

Not classified as hazardous, however we advise that normal cleaning safety practises are adopted. Wear rubber gloves when handling and avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention if irritation persists.
